That Friday morning, we will meet at a gas station on the southside (On Cue on I-35 most likely) and caravan (to some degree) to a notable craft beer restaurant in Texas for lunch. From there, it's then to hotel for check in before the traffic is unbearable.



- The event is at the <u>Sheraton DFW Airport Hotel</u> 4440 West John Carpenter Freeway Irving, Texas 75063. The group room rate of \$99 per night and rooms at this rate are still available.
- The event cost per person is \$50 for the whole weekend bluebonnet event and tickets are available at the <u>bluebonnet website</u>.
- Complimentary beer at hotel is available starting at 2 PM on both Saturday and Sunday.
- Keynote speaker at 7PM on Friday.
- Then it's the commercial beer showcase Friday night from 8PM till midnight. A very good opportunity to get that untappd check in count up as there are hundreds of local land regional beers available to try. "Trust me on this one", said local homebrewer Brian Hendry.
