Pandemic Related Policy Changes

Until further notice, the club is going to discontinue the style of the month share table, homebrew and other homebrew/beer share table and snack table. (We consider those to be on par with buffets which are not supposed to allow shared items.) We decided that everyone crowding around tables with everyone touching all the bottles is not a safe practice. Club members will be allowed to bring their homebrews/beers to drink at club meetings, but any sharing is between the two members and please be safe (i.e pour your beer into their glass without touching it.) CTZ Challenge

Our friends at Angry Scotsman Brewing wound up with entirely too many CTZ hops. Red Earth Brewers to the rescue! We are planning a competition for our July meeting featuring beers our members brew with CTZ hops. Angry Scotsman will donate the CTZ hops for the beer you plan to brew. Brew any beer (no ciders, meads, perry, etc.) style that you want, but the beer must feature ONLY CTZ hops. The BJCP style of beer you brewed must be declared when you enter your beer. Hops are still available for you to pick up and you have plenty of time to brew your beer. It looks like we have 10 people interested so far in this competition - I have sent everyone their entry number. If you want to enter the competition and don't have an entry number, please contact David Johnson.

- Three 12 OZ generic bottles required per entry.
- Drop off your entries from **7-6-20 thru 7-12-20** at Angry Scotsman Brewing during normal taproom hours.
- Beers will be judged by a combination of REB BJCP certified judges and brewers from Angry Scotsman Brewing.
- Everyone that enters this competition will get a gift bag of swag - hops, yeast, Star San, etc.
- Each bottle must have a bottle label attached - 2015 BJCP Style, entry number and special ingredients if required.

- Please attach the labels with a rubber band and use generic bottle caps.
- Judging will be Best of Show format - there will not be score sheets provided for each beer.
- There is no fee to enter this competition.
- One entry per member.
- Entries dropped off after 7-12-20 will not be judged.

- REB medals for 1st – 2nd – 3rd

Competitions outside the Club

The best way to improve your brewing skills is to enter competitions. It's one thing to ask your friends if your beer tastes good, but quite another to have some random certified judge do a detailed evaluation and provide unvarnished advice on where you might have gone wrong or could improve your style. The club is looking at ideas to increase member participation in competitions. (That is once they start up again.)

Beer Judge Certification Program (BJCP)

BJCP certification is a great way to greatly expand your knowledge of homebrewing, beer styles and common beer flaws. The club has expended resources in the past to help many club members become certified, expand their knowledge and ultimately play a leading role in judging our competitions. The nature of this beast is that for the club to embark on another round of helping people become certified, we need 10-15 people seriously interested before the club will buy the materials and invest the time. We will be gauging club interest in certification. The first step in the process is to pass an online Beer Judge Entrance exam. After passing, you have 2 years to complete the tasting exam. The club will reimburse the entrance exam fee of \$10 for any club member that sits for the tasting exam (you must get a seat). There is also a Mead judging certification program and there are a few club members currently pursuing this type of certification. If you are a big mead fan and are interested in becoming certified judge of meads, please contact our resident expert, Bert Renard, for further details regarding study events that he hopes to do soon to catch an upcoming scheduled exam. Brewer of the Year (BOTY) and Member of the Year (MOTY)

Don't forget that the club tracks participation in the club activities and competition awards and gives out prizes (1st, 2nd and 3rd for each) at the December (Christmas Party) meeting. With competitions mostly cancelled and pouring events postponed so far, the winners may have few points. For pouring events this year, we are aware of the OKC Marathon, OCBF (1 August) and ZooBrew (they hope to have in the fall sometime). The only competitions that we know of are our Red Earth Brewers competitions.

Officer Elections

At our September meeting, we have officer elections. Elected officers serve terms of two years and we have staggered the elections so there is not a complete turnover. This September, we have the Vice President and one Member at Large position open. The VP is primarily responsible for running competitions and the Members at Large track attendance at monthly meetings and provide an interface with the club members.
