<u>The Brew Shop</u> has graciously offered to be our entry collection point. You can drop off your entries at the brew shop from **January 13th till the close of business January 20th**.

When you register, you will want to select "Homebrew Headquarters" as your drop off point. Then select "Red Earth Brewers" as your club.

Entry Info:

Bluebonnet is a massive competition, in order to manage the chaos, they are very particular with how they want their entries prepared.

Entries must be paid for within 24 hours or they will be removed. So, after you add your entries, go ahead and pay first thing.

Once you've paid, you'll be able to print your labels.

Entries require **THREE 12oz brown bottles with plain caps**. You will need to affix a bottle label to each bottle with a rubber band **DO NOT TAPE LABELS ON THE BOTTLE**. Additionally, there is an entry form that will print with your labels. Fold that in half and rubber band that to one of the entry bottles.

Then you will need to package up your entries in a sealed box, just like you were going to ship the entries. They will not allow us to drop-off lose six pack holders full of entries.

Beer Judge Certification Program (BJCP)

BJCP certification is a great way to greatly expand your knowledge of homebrewing, beer styles and common beer flaws. The club has expended resources in the past to help many club members become certified, expand their knowledge and ultimately play a leading role in judging our competitions. The nature of this beast is that for the club to embark on another round of helping people become certified, we need 10-15 people seriously interested before the club will buy the materials and invest the time. We will be gauging club interest in certification. The first step in the process is to pass an online Beer Judge Entrance exam. After passing, you have 2 years to complete the tasting exam. The club will reimburse the entrance

exam fee of \$10 for any club member that sits for the tasting exam (you must get a seat). Further details regarding the program can be found here: BJCP Exam Structure

There is also a Mead judging certification program and there are a few club members currently pursuing this type of certification. If you are a big mead fan and are interested in becoming certified judger of meads, please contact our resident expert, Burt Renard, for further details regarding study events that he hopes to do soon to catch an upcoming scheduled exam. (He's a member on the club's Facebook Group and can be messaged. If you don't know him, ask one of the club board members.)

Brewer of the Year (BOTY) and Tom Challis Club Member of the Year (CMOTY)

Don't forget that the club tracks participation in the club activities and competition awards and gives out prizes (1st, 2nd and 3rd for each) at the December (Christmas Party) meeting. With competitions mostly cancelled and pouring events postposed so far, the winners may have few points.
