Stay tuned for sign-up sheets as we get closer to the events.

If you would like to participate, you should know a few things.

- **BREW** we are going to need beer for these events.
- Be a member. Red Earth carries insurance for our club and its members. Your name is listed as a member under the coverage. We cannot let you pour beer at our booth if you are not a member.
- Have a current ABLE Cider/Wine/Beer Personal Use Permit. You can find instructions and a link to ABLE's
  website <a href="mailto:here">here</a>. Then, you need to email it to <a href="mailto:redearthbrewers@gmail.com">redearthbrewers@gmail.com</a>. This is so that we are following ABLE regulations.
- There will always be a sign-up sheet for each pouring event. This helps plan the event and lets us know who is
  going and what they are bringing. Keep an eye out for them on our <u>facebook paid member group</u> or our <u>website</u>.
- If you donate beer to the event, you get 1 point per gallon toward your Tom Challis Club Member of the Year
  points.
- Typically, when you sign up, you are allowed to bring a +1 to the event to help you pour. But we are NOT
  guaranteed this allotment. Just know it is a highly likely possibility. Again, that +1 MUST be a member.

#### **BREWER OF THE YEAR & CLUB MEMBER OF THE YEAR**

The Red Earth Brewer of the Year and Club Member of the Year Awards are given to the members that accumulate the most club points over the course of the calendar year. Points are earned for all the different activities of the club. It is meant to encourage participation in all aspects of the Red Earth Brewers Homebrew Club. The member with the highest net score in each category at the end of year wins the title of "Red Earth Brewer of the Year" or "Tom Challis Club Member of the Year" and receives significant prizes. Points are accumulated per the scheme shown in the table below.
